People believe that burning grass is a good thing... but it is destructive and dangerous.

Grass fires don't control weeds... they make weeds worse by clearing the ground so weed seeds germinate.

Grass fires don't improve your lawn... they reduce your grass by half.

Grass fires don't make your lawn look greener... it just looks that way because the ground is black.

Grass fires are bad for our natural resources... they kill important habitat for birds and small animals.

Grass fires are bad for the soil... nutrients go up in smoke.

Grass fires are bad for the environment... they release carbon dioxide into the atmosphere.
